

Call changes

- At Ranmoor bells are “**called up**” i.e. the bell ringing in front is called to ring after the bell following it
- The change takes effect at the next hand stroke

In the following examples the bells start in rounds. **Your** bell is in **bold**

Change being rung								Call	Effect on change next hand stroke								What you have to do
